



ATTENTION HIGHLAND PARK RESIDENTS

The Department of Public Works will now be accepting the following Fluorescent lighting items:

Compact Fluorescent Lamps (CFLs)

Fluorescent Tubes (up to 8 ft. length)

U-Shaped Bulbs

Bulbs will be accepted as part of the Electronics Recycling Drop-Off program. Only “residentially generated” materials will be accepted. NO “commercially generated” items will be accepted, **NO EXCEPTIONS**.

The following guidelines **must be adhered** to ensure safe delivery and handling of materials:

- Broken bulbs **will not** be accepted
- Individual CFLs **must** be place in a sealed sandwich bag
- Tubes **must** be taped together, in bundles 4 or less, of same length

Materials will be accepted at the Public Works garage, 444 Valentine St. Monday through Friday, between 7:00 am to 2:30 pm.
