 - Changing the location to the Senior Center; This raised the concern that people may feel uncomfortable coming in to get a free meal in such a public place
 - Can families get a voucher to go to the Deli for their lunch?
 - Offering an activity for children to draw them in for lunch
 - Meals on wheels type of home delivery
 - HP Gives a Hoot ID card sent home to show at certain restaurants in town
 - Sending vouchers home to all free/reduced lunch families to use
3. The Survey was reviewed and suggestions made as to the wording and how to distribute. Idea discussed to send survey and vouchers to 30 eligible families to see their response.
