Minutes

- 1. Meeting was called to order at 7:10 PM
- 2. Approval of June minutes.
- 3. Finance Report: Account balance reported at \$12, 446. \$4,640 will go to the sponsored camp scholarships. With that balance, we likely about enough money to cover the upcoming costs of lunches served at Global Grace and at HP camp to students eligible for free/reduced lunch.
- 4. Summer Lunch program: From 6/25 through 7/5 88 lunches were served at Global Grace to Gives a Hoot guests. Mike has been picking up the data sheets each week and supplying GG with additional frozen pizza. Most of our guests are eating food served at GG.
- 5. Camp lunch status: USDA is not providing lunches this year. Next year if 50% of campers are eligible for free/reduced lunch they will. For this year, we will cover the costs at \$3.45 per lunch per camper for each of the eligible campers.
- 6. Peer to Peer mentoring: Mike has scheduled a meeting for August 14th to review high school plans for this program.
- 7. July 2nd fireworks: \$113 was collected. There were very few volunteers. Next year, it would be better to collect as people came in to the park. Additional volunteers are needed to make this collection successful. High school students, those involved in the mentoring program, should be encouraged to volunteer.
- 8. Status of Summer Basketball Request: This has been tabled given the unexpected cost of camp lunches. The basketball program has been given additional money from a Block grant.
- 9. Publicity for Hoot: Flyers have been distributed around town. Signage is needed around Global Grace Café. Eva will follow up. A banner is needed for future collections. Evelyn will follow up on this
- 10. New Business: Fund raising needs for next year: solicitation letter from the Mayor, approaching the PTA and Education Foundation, collecting at the Arts Fair were discussed.
