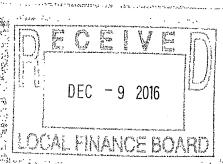

For example, for fiscal years ending December 31, 2017, the calendar year 2015 W-2 and 1099 should be used (60 days prior to start of budget year is November 1, 2016, with 2014 being the most recent calendar year ended), and for fiscal years ending June 30, 2018, the calendar year 2016 W-2 and 1099 should be used (60 days prior to start of budget year is May 1, 2017, with 2016 being the most recent calendar year ended).
- Other Public Entity: Any municipality, county, local authority, fire district, or other government unit, regardless of whether it is related in any way to the Authority either by function or by physical location.
