Minutes

- 1. Meeting was called to order at 7:31 PM. All participants were on a zoom call because of the need for physical distancing due to the Covid-19 situation.
- 2. Update on 501c3 status since last agenda. After various discussions with the Borough and the HP Food Pantry, it is looking like the difficulty of the process may stop us from pursuing it.
- 3. Food distribution is running smoothly, except for the snow. No pickup from McFoods last week and today because they were closed. Monica and Ashton have arranged for regular purchases from the local Stop and Shop directly by the Borough. Monica reports January's food purchases as \$510.80. Currently, 25-30 families are being provided groceries each week. Discussion about how else we can be supporting families in need that are connected to the Teem Center.
- 4. Summer Camp: Monica has begun soliciting applications for Scholarships to the Boro's Summer Camp. We will award up to 20 scholarships at about \$320 each, or about \$6400. If there is a strong response to the solicitation, we will consider offering more scholarships.
