- 3. **Motion to buy 40 Stop and Shop gift cards at \$25 each (=\$1,000)** to be distributed at Ashton Burrell's discretion as a holiday bonus.
- 4. **United Way/Door Dash food delivery opportunity.** I forwarded a lengthy email from Replenish to call your attention to the item "New Food Delivery Program". Anyone interested in following up to see if this works for us, let me know.
- 5. **Replenish Awards.** Another "Forward" FYI Replenish's awards show something about their inner workings.
- 6. Windows of Understanding Art for Hoot. John Marron fiched Robert Diken, artist and head of the Metuchen Arts Council, into creating a work for Hoot to be displayed in the "Voices of 9/11" storefront on Albany street. Mike, John, and Robert met at the Teen Center to explain our work. Robert will create a mock-up proposal for approval of WOU and then by us. Thanks to John and Robert!
- New Driver. Thomas Castles had joined our diver crew. With Evelyn Sedehi we now have 5
