Why soak up the rain?

- 1. Rain water that sinks into the ground nourishes life
- 2. Stormwater runoff transports pollutants into down-stream water bodies. It erodes streams. It floods and poisons our homes, our towns, and farms where our food is grown.

How to soak up the rain?



Downspout directs rain to the driveway and street; rain becomes stormwater runoff.



Downspout directs rain to landscaped area; rain soaks into the ground.

Notice where the water goes and redirect it!
