RESOLUTION OPPOSING NJ DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE PROPOSED RULE PRN 2017-216 REGARDING BEEKEEPING

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Agriculture has promulgated new beekeeping rules designated as PRN 2017-216 in the New Jersey Register which are now open to public comment, which comments must be submitted by January 19, 2018; and,

WHEREAS, the delegates to the 102nd State Agricultural Convention, assembled in Atlantic City, New Jersey, on February 8-9, 2017, adopted Resolution #21, which found that:

honeybees are vital components of New Jersey agriculture; and

honeybees forage over airsheds measured in square miles, not acres; and,

New Jersey's beekeepers provide their pollination services to other commodity producers, and produce honey and hive products without the necessity for control of their own land base, unlike all other types of commercial agriculture; and,

the Right to Farm Act is intended to protect Commercial Farms engaged in generally accepted agricultural management practices from over-restrictive local regulation nuisance lawsuits; and,

since 2006, there has been a tremendous increase in public awareness of the extreme honeybee colony losses routinely suffered by beekeepers around the country, and of the threat that the loss of honeybees and other pollinators poses to our food supply and quality of life; and

increased public awareness has resulted in a corresponding increase in the numbers of beekeepers in New Jersey, who now number in the thousands; and,

many of the state's increasing number of beekeepers are non-commercial or do not operate on a scale or in a location that could make them eligible for exemptions from local regulation of beekeeping practices under the Right to Farm Act; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed regulations include Apiary Standards which prohibit new beekeeper hives on residential lots of less than one quarter (1/4/) acre which were not in existence as of July 31, 2015; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed regulations provide that beekeepers may seek a waiver to keep no more than two (2) hives on a residential lot of one quarter (1/4) acre to less than five (5) acres, which waiver requirements may be used to ban existing non-commercial beekeeping; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed regulations require hives to be located at least ten (10) feet from any property line, twenty five (25) fee from any roadway, sidewalk or path, eighty five (85) feet from any public place, and mandate a Flyway Barrier of six (6) feet or more and extending more at least ten (10) feet beyond the colony in all directions; and,

WHEREAS, these proposed regulations were developed in spirit and practice without reference or input from the State's beekeeper organizations and contrary to the findings of the State Agricultural Convention in Resolution # 21; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed regulations effectively prohibit beekeeping on all but commercial properties and needlessly add restrictive regulations which are contrary to good Apiary practice, injurious to native plants which require pollination, and ban residential and hobbyist beekeeping:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Highland Park that the Borough of Highland Park opposes the adoption of the proposed regulations prescribing new rules for commercial and non-commercial beekeeping in New Jersey as contrary to good Apiary practice, without basis in current best beekeeping practices, and excessively restrictive to small and hobbyist beekeepers, and urges the New Jersey Department of Agriculture to recall the regulations and establish a joint review commission composed of commercial and non-commercial beekeepers, representatives of New Jersey beekeeping organizations, scientists and representatives of the New Jersey Department of Agriculture to propose appropriate regulations for beekeeping in New Jersey.
