1. Section 3-3 of the "Code of the Borough of Highland Park 2010" concerning Borough Council meeting is amended to read as follows:

§ 3-3. Meetings

Thereafter, the Borough Council shall neet regularly within the Borough at such times and places as provided by resolution. The Mayor shall, when necessary, call special meetings of the Council. In case of the neglect correfusal, any four members of the Council may call such meetings at such meetings, notice shall be given to all members of the Council or left at their places of residence. Notice of all meetings shall be given in accordance with the requirements of the Open Fulic Meetings Law, c. 231, P.L. 1975.

In accordance with Article IV of the Runs of runs, during the Borough Council Meeting a period of 15 minutes shall be allocated or sublic discussion following the delivery at said meeting of reports by the Counce Mays and other Borough professionals. There shall be an additional public rescussion period provided before the adoption of any executive session resolution, if nonline council fore adjournment to the Council's Conference Meeting.

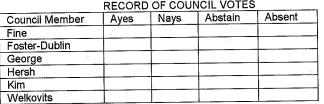

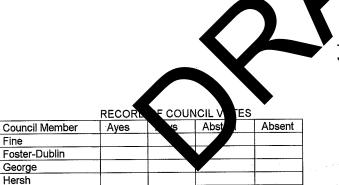

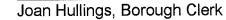
